**Explanation of Responses:**

- Restricted stock units of ExlService Holdings, Inc. (the "Company") convert into common stock, par value \$0.001 per share (the "Common Stock") on a one-for-one basis.
- The reporting person's restricted stock units reported in this report vested on February 22, 2019. Pursuant to the Company's 2015 Amendment and Restatement of the 2006 Omnibus Award Plan, pursuant to which such restricted stock units were granted, the closing price of the Common Stock on the Nasdaq Global Select Market on the preceding day is used for purposes of computing tax reporting and withholding.
- The reporting person's restricted stock units reported in this report vested on February 23, 2019. Pursuant to the Company's 2015 Amendment and Restatement of the 2006 Omnibus Award Plan, pursuant to which such restricted stock units were granted, the closing price of the Common Stock on the Nasdaq Global Select Market on the preceding day is used for purposes of computing tax reporting and withholding.
- On February 22, 2018, the reporting person was granted 6,655 restricted stock units, vesting in four equal annual installments beginning on the first anniversary of the grant date. 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 22, 2019, an additional 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 22, 2020, an additional 25 percent of the restricted stock units will vest on February 22, 2021, and the remaining balance of 25 percent of the restricted stock units will vest on February 22, 2022.
- On February 23, 2017, the reporting person was granted 5,445 restricted stock units, vesting in four equal annual installments beginning on the first anniversary of the grant date. 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 23, 2018, an additional 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 23, 2019, an additional 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 23, 2020, and the remaining balance of 25 percent of the restricted stock units will vest on February 23, 2021.
